



Environmental Policy Statement



Egan Waste Services Limited is committed to providing and continually improving a comprehensive and effective waste management service throughout South Wales; based on safeguarding both the local and global environment. This policy will complement our overall plan of promoting sustainable business practices and where applicable developing cleaner technologies. Our Environmental Management System will provide the framework for setting and reviewing our environmental objectives and targets.

We are committed to conducting our business in a manner that protects the environment, supports the ecological use of resources, providing the minimisation of waste and the prevention of pollution. At the heart of this commitment is our endeavour to recover and re-use natural resources through our recycling and re-use facilities; and only use landfill as a last resort.

Egan Waste Services maintains, a documented Environmental Management System (EMS). This addresses and meets the requirements of ISO 14001, and in turn helps to meet the requirements of our Environmental Permit also. By utilising the 14001 framework and Best Available Techniques (BAT), Egan Waste can continually improve both our environmental performance and our EMS as a whole. This is partly achieved by identifying possible initiatives and setting and using environmental objectives to consider and achieve them.

The various activities undertaken by Egan Waste Services are documented within the EMS; details of which are communicated to employees and interested Third Parties; we believe that meeting these standards is the responsibility of the whole team. Procedures make provision for the setting, monitoring and achievement of environmental objectives aimed at improving performance on environmental issues, and ensuring that the company adheres to and keeps up to date with environmental legislation.

It is our aim, irrespective of any regulations or legislation, to be a good neighbour and to reduce to an absolute minimum the likelihood of pollution, and minimise any environmental impacts arising from our activities in collecting, managing and disposing of both public and commercial waste.

Risk based thinking is used and applied to help prevent or mitigate potential problems. The continuing suitability of our EMS is maintained by means of Non-conformance control, Internal audit and Management review processes. In order to continually improve the company's performance, measurable Environmental Objectives are set and reviewed regularly along with annual sectorial benchmarking.

All Egan Waste Services employees are informed of the company's Environmental Policy, and meeting these standards is the responsibility of the entire team. Egan Waste Services Environmental Policy is continually reviewed to ensure it is still appropriate to the needs of the business and the EMS as a whole.
